

## **GETTING HERE:**

### **By Road**

Cardigan / Aberteifi, Ceredigion

Travelling from the South of Wales, South West of England and South East of England:

You take the M4 then A48 to Carmarthen and then either travel via Newcastle Emlyn or St Clears - both routes are long, small (picturesque!) country roads and will require a sat nav or similar to navigate. It takes around two hours to get here by road from Cardiff.

Travelling from North Wales, the Midlands and the North of England:

You can either travel via Aberystwyth or Llandovery/Carmarthen. Aberystwyth is about an hour North of Cardigan, Llandovery is an hour and a half East.

### **By Train**

The nearest train stations are Clynderwen, Carmarthen and Aberystwyth.

From London, Great Western Railway/ Transport for Wales run an hourly service from London Paddington to Swansea with connections along a beautiful, coastal route to Carmarthen and Clynderwen (journey time 4-5 hours).

From Birmingham there is a regular service every two hours to Aberystwyth. Again a delightful train journey with some lovely views particularly from Machynlleth along the Dyfi estuary.

From Manchester there is a regular service to Aberystwyth, you will need to change at Shrewsbury.

You will need to organise onward travel from the train (either by local bus or taxi)

### **By Coach**

National Express coaches have stops in Carmarthen, St Clears and Aberystwyth.

Megabus coaches stop in Carmarthen, Lampeter and Aberystwyth

## **By Air**

The nearest international airport is Cardiff. You will need to organise onward travel using a mix of bus/coach/train/taxi or car hire.

For those not driving, there are local buses, trains, local taxis (see above for more information). There are also a limited number of car hire services at both ferry terminals.

## **Tips**

If you are travelling part way by train along the south Wales train route, and getting picked up by car part way along that route, either Port Talbot or Newport train stations are closest to the M4.

If travelling by train and then taxi, the most economical option would be to travel to Clynderwen by train and then take a taxi from there, but call to book a taxi ahead of time.

Whichever route you are taking, we would strongly advise that you double check availability before travelling.

○ Fanceinion mae gwasanaeth rheolaidd i Aberystwyth, bydd angen i chi newid yn Amwythig.
